Committee Reports

Food Services

Evening Ladies: Nothing new to report

Men's League: The recent bonspiel was reported as successful although down to 24 teams from 32 last year.

Sportsmen League: League reports it is doing well.

CFB League: Although there are 12 teams registered, there is usually only 3-4 sheets used per draw.

Senior Men's: Registration is down slightly. The league has decided to play mornings only using 6 sheets with one bye. The interclub spiel consisted of 4 Glen Meadows rinks, one from Victoria and none from JDF.

Rebels League: The league has 12 teams , up 4 teams from last year.

Mixed Novice: The league is down to 8 teams. Food services has been requested and received for the shorty in January.

Youth Program: The program has 8 curlers. It was noted the fees have been raised. The issue of Curl BCV fees for youths was raised. the issue of whether

there was a way to help out the junior curlers financially. Ed and Tony to discuss.

Forester League : The league is down to 8 teams from 13 last year.

Other business:

The coupon program is not viable due to food service change.

There was motion to support all leagues with \$150, the youth program \$100. There would also be funding of \$200 for teams traveling to second tier playdowns.
